Reception Admissions 2024

It is time to apply for a school; reception class place for the September 2024 intake.

• If your child's date of birth falls on or between 1 September 2019 to 31 August 2020, now is the time to apply for a Reception Class place for September 2024.

• There is no automatic transfer from nursery – everyone must apply between 12 September 2023 and 15 January 2024 by completing the application form of the Local Authority in which you live.

• Knowsley residents should apply by accessing the online application portal via the Knowsley website www.knowsley.gov.uk.

 It is the responsibility of the parent/carer to ensure they have read the admission policy of each school they are considering applying for and provide all the information required to support their application. St Aloysius requires you to fill in a supplementary faith form.
Your child must be baptised before the 15th January to be classed as a baptised catholic under our admission criteria.
