



RHSE Statement

The governors at St Aloysius Catholic Primary School have adopted the 'Journey In Love' resource to support the non-statutory relationships and sex education across the school from Nursery to Year 6. The programme of study is authentic to the teaching of the Catholic Church. An aspect of the mystery of love is taught in each year group:

Reception: The wonder of being special and unique

Year 1: We meet God's love in our family

Year 2: We meet God's love in the community

Year 3: How we live in love

Year 4: God loves us in our differences

Year 5: God loves me in my changing and development

Year 6: The wonder of God's love in creating new life

In each year group, the programme consists of 5 areas:

- Physical
- Social
- Emotional
- Intellectual
- Spiritual

Each area is broken down into:

- Activities
- Pause and Reflect
- Prayer

As part of our commitment to you, we will hold a meeting annually for the parents and carers of children across the school to discuss the programme. Parents have the right to withdraw their children from the non-statutory component of sex education in Year 6. This is where sexual intercourse is taught discretely as part of the physical aspect within Journey In Love resource
