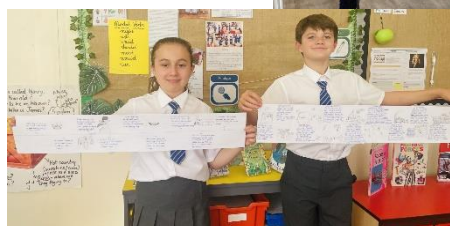
### Key Stage 1 –Years 1 & 2
